While dark clouds still hover over the Church and likely will do so for some time to come, we know it is important that we carry on with as much vigor as possible the mission of Jesus to seek and save those who are lost. Jesus is still Lord and always will be! And He is certainly coming to judge the living and the dead! We want to do all we can to be ready ourselves and to help as many as possible also be ready for the judgment! And what an amazing year it has been, once again, thanks to your support.

HERE IS A QUICK RECAP OF OUR YEAR IN NUMBERS:

- 38 YEARS OF Renewal Ministries
- 34 YEARS OF The Choices We Face
- 24 YEARS OF Food for the Journey

- » 470,000 views of our YouTube programs.
- » 5,000 Facebook followers.
- » 132,471 distinct visitors to the website from 192 countries—a thirty-two percent increase!
- » Forty-one missions to thirty-four countries.
- » Tens of thousands of booklets, books, CDs, and DVDs distributed.

We were able to carry out forty-one missions to thirty-four countries, helping to strengthen the Church in those countries and helping many thousands of Catholics to surrender their lives more fully to Jesus and follow Him as missionary disciples. In about twenty-five percent of these missions, we were able to directly impact seminarians, priests, and bishops through events specifically for them. I personally have been involved in more international missions than ever with trips to Ireland, Holland, Argentina, Brazil, Uganda, and Lithuania—mostly directed to strengthening the clergy and lay-leadership in those countries, as well as retreats for deacons and their wives in both the US and Canada.

Besides the international missions, Peter, Sr. Ann, and myself, as well as our close collaborators such as Dr. Mary Healy, have done innumerable parish missions, conferences, study days, radio interviews, newspaper interviews, and board memberships, all of which we do for one purpose only:

TO ADVANCE THE GOSPEL.

And our outreach to young adults, i.d.9:16, continues to grow! In its eighth year, it now numbers fifteen chapters representing twelve states and eleven dioceses. Also, Pete Burak, our young adult coordinator, continues to be asked to serve on various boards and committees to help the Church reach out to young adults. This outreach has been significantly involved in putting on five Millennial Church Conferences to assist those involved in young adult ministry to grow in their effectiveness. Also, their social media presence has continued to grow, with over 4,000 new followers on Instagram.

Our overall Renewal Ministries' media outreach also has taken big steps forward. We have seen an eighty-percent increase in our YouTube channel subscribers this year, with 470,000 cumulative total views of our programs on YouTube. And we have had 132,471 unique website users visit our website from 192 different countries.

And how amazing it is that we have completed the thirty-eighth year of our mission of Catholic Renewal and Evangelization, as well as our thirtyfourth year of taping another twentysix episodes of The Choices We Face, o our long-running weekly television program carried worldwide by EWTN! Additionally, Sr. Ann's radio program, Food for the Journey, has been on the air for twenty-four years, and Peter Herbeck's program, Fire on the Earth, has been broadcast for thirteen years.

We also have continued to produce books, CDs, DVDs, booklets, and articles that have been distributed widely and oftentimes translated into various languages.

The Lord has continued to give us and our close collaborators the special privilege of teaching at Sacred Heart Major Seminary, helping to

form future priests and lay leaders in a dynamic vision of the Catholic faith.

My letter, Dear Troubled Catholics, received more response than anything we've ever sent out, was widely distributed to countless thousands and shared on many other ministries' websites, and was picked up in various publications, on-line and printed, besides being quoted by priests and bishops in their responses to the crisis. We ourselves, on our website and various social media outlets, recorded over 40,000 unique views on our website blog for this post alone.

Peter Herbeck's follow-up letter, A Severe Mercy, also was met with a strong response, with over 17,000 people reached just by our Facebook post.

There's more, but you get the idea. The Lord has blessed us greatly with the people, finances, and open doors that have enabled us to reach many thousands for Christ this past year.

This would not have been possible without your support. Will you please consider a special "end of the year" gift—a "Thanks offering"—that will launch us into 2019 with the strength to continue and even expand what we are doing? Ever since 1980, when we first began and I first began to speak on the "crisis of truth" in the Catholic Church, the Lord has given us the privilege of being a strong and clear voice for the Gospel in times of great confusion. Ellen Holian-Mykrantz

January 3, 1941 -September 2, 2018



The above quote echoes the sentiments found in many of the emails we have recently received about Ellen Holian-Mykrantz, who served as a member of Renewal Ministries' Board of Directors for eighteen years, from 1998-2016. She passed away after a courageous battle with cancer on Sept. 2, 2018, at age seventy-seven, after receiving a blessing from her brother, who is a priest, and praying an Our Father and Hail Mary with family.

Ellen was an active evangelizer and prayer warrior. She had a heart for missions, and was both a Right to Life and retreat leader. She loved spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. Ellen is survived by her loving husband, Christopher Mykrantz, seven children, five siblings, twenty-seven grandchildren, and seventeen great-grandchildren.

Ralph Martin was able to travel to Richmond, Illinois, for the wake, and Sr. Ann Shields and Renewal Ministries' Board Member Tom O'Brien were able to be there for the funeral.

As another letter noted, "'A woman of noble character who can find?' We all found one in Ellen. May she be swept up into the heart of eternal love."

Dear Peter,

A few years ago, my brother started talking to me about your show and encouraging me to listen. He has always been the one in the family with what seemed to be a deeper understanding of God and our Catholic faith, but in my busy life, I just didn't think I had time to listen to a radio program . . . well one day, I happened to turn on the Catholic radio station. 


Ralph spoke at a retreat for deacons and their wives in Vancouver. He also gave a parish mission to about 400 people.




