


Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As the end of 2022 nears, we have a lot to be thankful for:

- We have been able to resume international travel and have carried out about thirty-three missions in twenty-five countries this year, after having all travel virtually stopped for many months because of Covid.
- The YouTube ministry that began to take off when we couldn't travel has continued to grow and reach people all over the world.
- id continued to strengthen young adult communities across the country (and even in Australia.)
- It was good to get back to week-long, inperson summer camps for middle-schoolaged boys and girls.
- We produced another excellent group of twenty-six new programs for our weekly EWTN program, *The Choices We Face*. This was our thirty-ninth year of production!
- Personally, I've never been busier and have had amazing opportunities to speak to priests all over the country—and world—with a ten-day trip to England this past spring and clergy convocations for the dioceses of San Jose, California; Buffalo, New York; and Tyler, Texas; and very big priests' conferences in San Diego, California; Austin, Texas; and Wheeling, West Virginia.

One personal blessing I received was being awarded a Defender of the Faith Award from the Caritas in Veritate Foundation along with



Cardinal Mueller (former head of the Vatican office charged with watching over doctrine in the Church) and Mary Ann Glendon (Harvard law professor and former ambassador to the Holy See). I agreed to travel to Phoenix to accept the award if I could have time with Cardinal Mueller, my current theological hero! I was delighted to have an open-ended breakfast with Cardinal Mueller one morning. He had given an endorsement for A Church in Crisis: Pathways Forward, which I was thrilled to receive, but I had never met him in person.

THE GATHERING

Dr. Mary Healy and Lavinia Spirito spoke on the theme *It is Time for a New Pentecost* at the Gathering, which was held in person in Ypsilanti, Michigan, for the first time since 2019.

Ralph Martin and Peter Herbeck also spoke at the event, on the themes *Living as Catholics in Challenging Times* and *It is Time for Courageous Witness*, respectively.

The Gathering was live streamed and has received over 27,000 online views since released.

LIFT JESUS HIGHER RALLY

The event's theme was *More Than Conquerors*, and in addition to those attending in person, nearly twenty-five thousand people have viewed the event online.

In 2023, the Lift Jesus Higher Rally will return as an in-person event in Toronto, Ontario.

This year, we started intentionally using Instagram, which has allowed us to reach a younger demographic; our reach is almost 90,000.







UGANDA | Renewal Ministries funded a Life in the Spirit Seminar for all of Uganda's 271 seminarians. The Emmaus Community led the seminar, which included priests, seminarians, and teachers.



Slovenia | Peter Herbeck traveled on mission to Slovenia with retiring Country Coordinator Don Turbitt. Their time in Slovenia included ministering to leaders of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal. Cameroon | Renewal Ministries led a mission to Cameroon to help facilitate personal and ministerial renewal for priests in two dioceses. We invited them into a greater openness to the role of the Holy Spirit in their lives and in the Church, and into the call to holiness and mission. We also taught the Five Keys of Unbound as a means to living in greater freedom.

BE LOVE REVOLUTION | Be Love Revolution (BLR) helps young women embrace their identity as daughters of the King. 2022 highlights include ministering weekly in three middle schools and a local Catholic high school, leading eight retreats for middle schools and high schools, and helping chapters grow in Michigan, Maryland, Florida, and Canada! Above, BLR hosts an early morning Bible study that hosts up to forty-plus participants each week!

ZION | Zion meets weekly to form young men into leaders and disciples of Jesus through community building, prayer, and mentorship from young adult male leaders. Below, high school boys gather at the Renewal Ministries' office for praise and worship.
